SPUTNIC is a one-year project supported by the European Commission under the Socrates, Accompanying Measures Programme. We have started our activities in January 2007 and the project will run until the end of December 2007.

SPUTNIC aims at raising awareness about the beneficial impact of the (pedagogically sound) implementation of new educational technologies that enhance international networking and collaboration for an institution, its staff and its students.
