- project duration: two years (01/01/2005 - 31/12/2006)



## Why?

Teachers and educational support staff:

- The necessary **technical, pedagogical and organizational support services** to ensure that **virtual mobility activities** easily embedded as an integrated part in the mainstream educational offer, are **missing**.

- and/or
- complementing the existing physical Erasmus exchange programmes with virtual preparatory and follow-up activities.



- The course is newly created in the institution and the same amount of credits is agreed upon by all partner institutions
- The course is newly created in the institution and the amount of credits is different in each partner institution
